Installation and commissioning

Given the travel restrictions of the past six months, evaluating the digital printing system has not been an easy task. Video calls and online demos were used to evaluate the machine in advance and Flyerline's team of specialists was finally able to test it thoroughly on a visit to the HP Experience Center in Barcelona, where the purchase agreement was finally signed. The CHROMOS Group AG service team will begin installing the new machine in the next few weeks,

after which it will provide operator training for employees. The machine will be commissioned in early August.
